



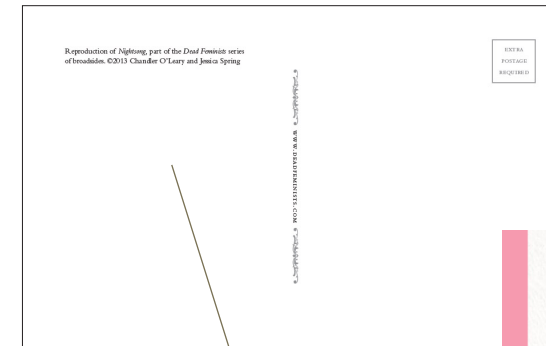
The Dead Feminists series is an ongoing collaboration between illustrator Chandler O’Leary and letterpress printer Jessica Spring, begun in 2008. The series features quotes by historical feminists, tied in with current political and social issues. Our limited-edition broadsides are letterpress printed from hand-drawn lettering and illustrations. Each broadside benefits a nonprofit cause that aligns with the issue highlighted by the artwork — our way of using the literal power of the press to change the world. These reproduction postcards faithfully capture the designs of the broadsides in an affordable, portable format.

Chandler received her BFA from the Rhode Island School of Design, and is the proprietor of an illustration and lettering business called Anagram Press. Jessica holds an MFA from the Center for Book and Paper Arts. She is a letterpress printer and teacher and the proprietor of Springtide Press. Both artists live and work in Tacoma, Washington. 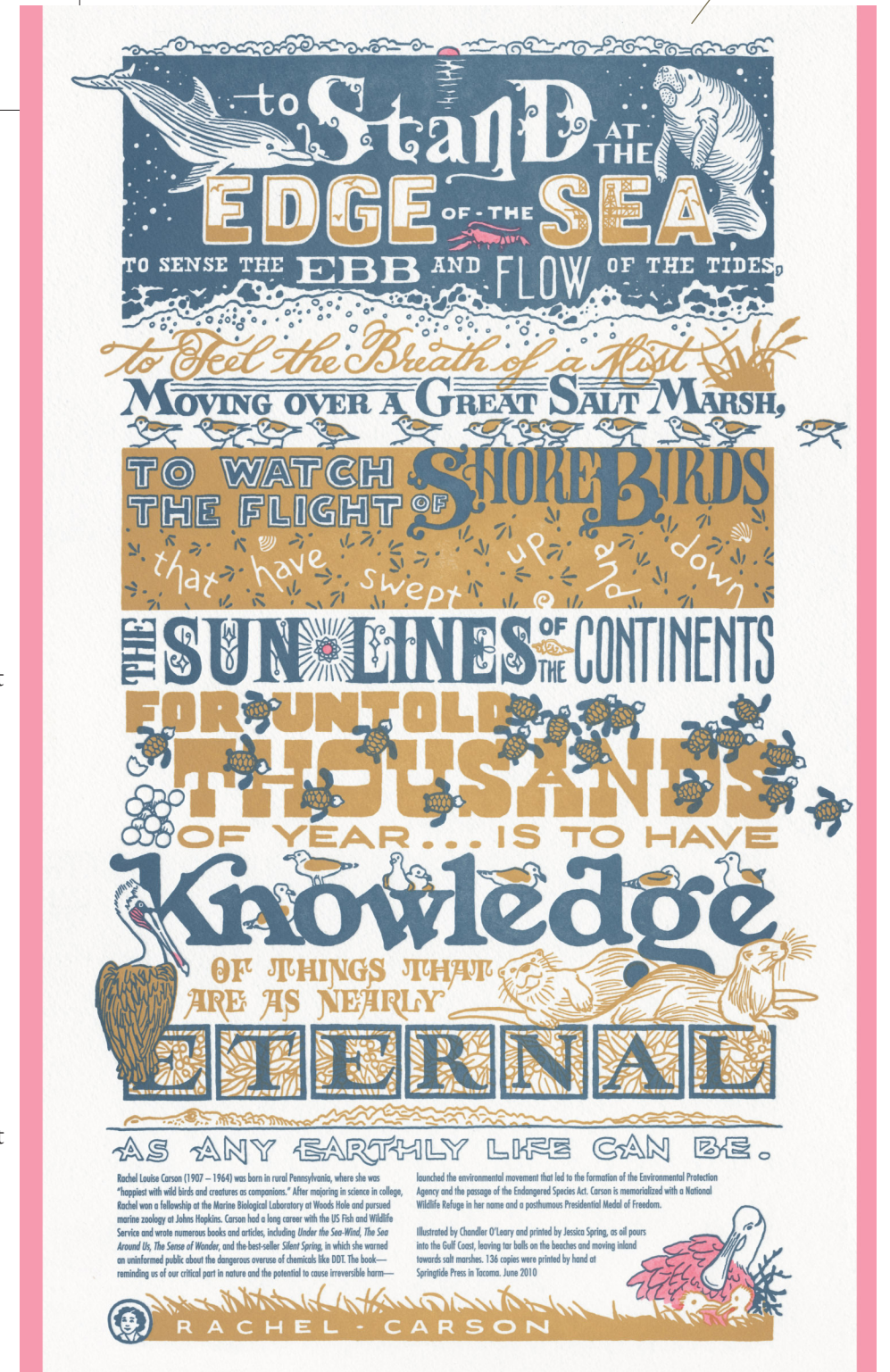

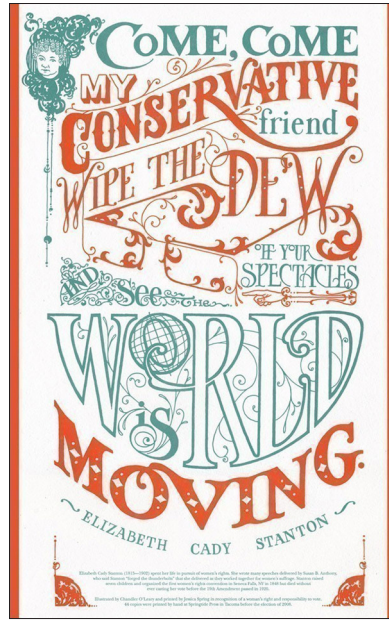

Postcard at actual size



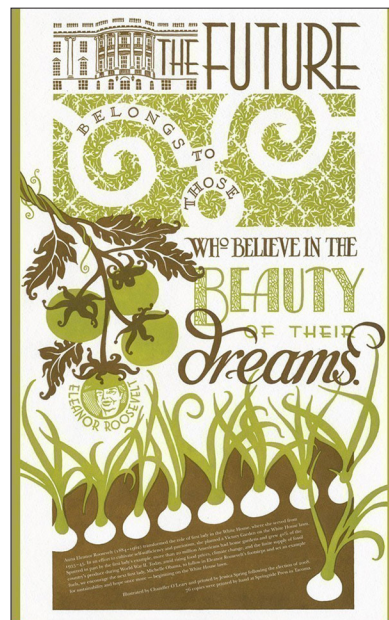

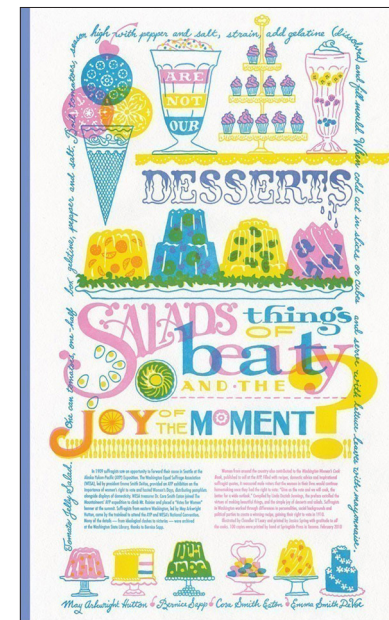

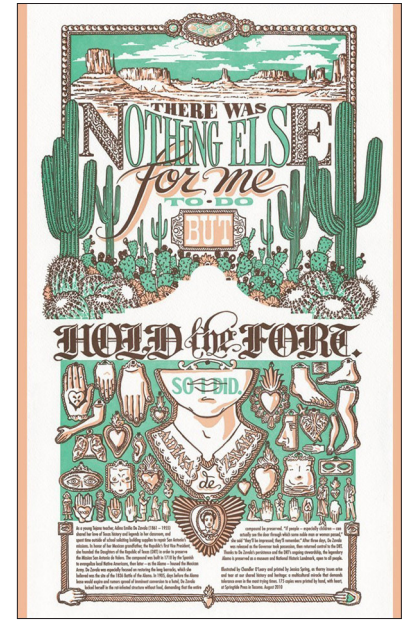

SHIPPING

All shipping costs are charged at time of order and will be included on your final invoice. Our normal carrier is USPS Priority; expedited shipping or UPS/Fedex service available at additional cost. All orders ship from Tacoma, WA; we are is not responsible for carrier delays or customs/duty fees.

TURNAROUND TIME

We generally ship within 3 business days from receipt of order (for new customers, all orders ship upon receipt of payment), although turnaround times may vary. If your order is time-sensitive, please contact us.

CANCELLATIONS & RETURNS

We ask that all cancellations or changes to your order be submitted within 24 hours of placing the order. Any

reductions to your order or cancellations not reported within 24 hours will be issued a restocking fee for up to 20% of the total deducted from your order. Incorrectly shipped merchandise or returns must be reported within 5 days of receipt, and returns or exchanges must be postmarked within 5 days of reporting. All merchandise must be returned unopened, unused, and in its original packaging.

BACK ORDERS

Occasionally certain products may be out of stock, or in the midst of being re-stocked. You will be notified of any items that are back-ordered, and if directed, we will proceed to ship all items in stock from your order. Once an item is back in stock, we will ship it out immediately unless directed otherwise.

LIMITED EDITIONS

Because our original letterpress broadsides are printed in small quantities and very limited editions, we are not able to offer them for wholesale. We hope you will understand.

We print all of our paper goods in the United States, using the highest-quality materials available.

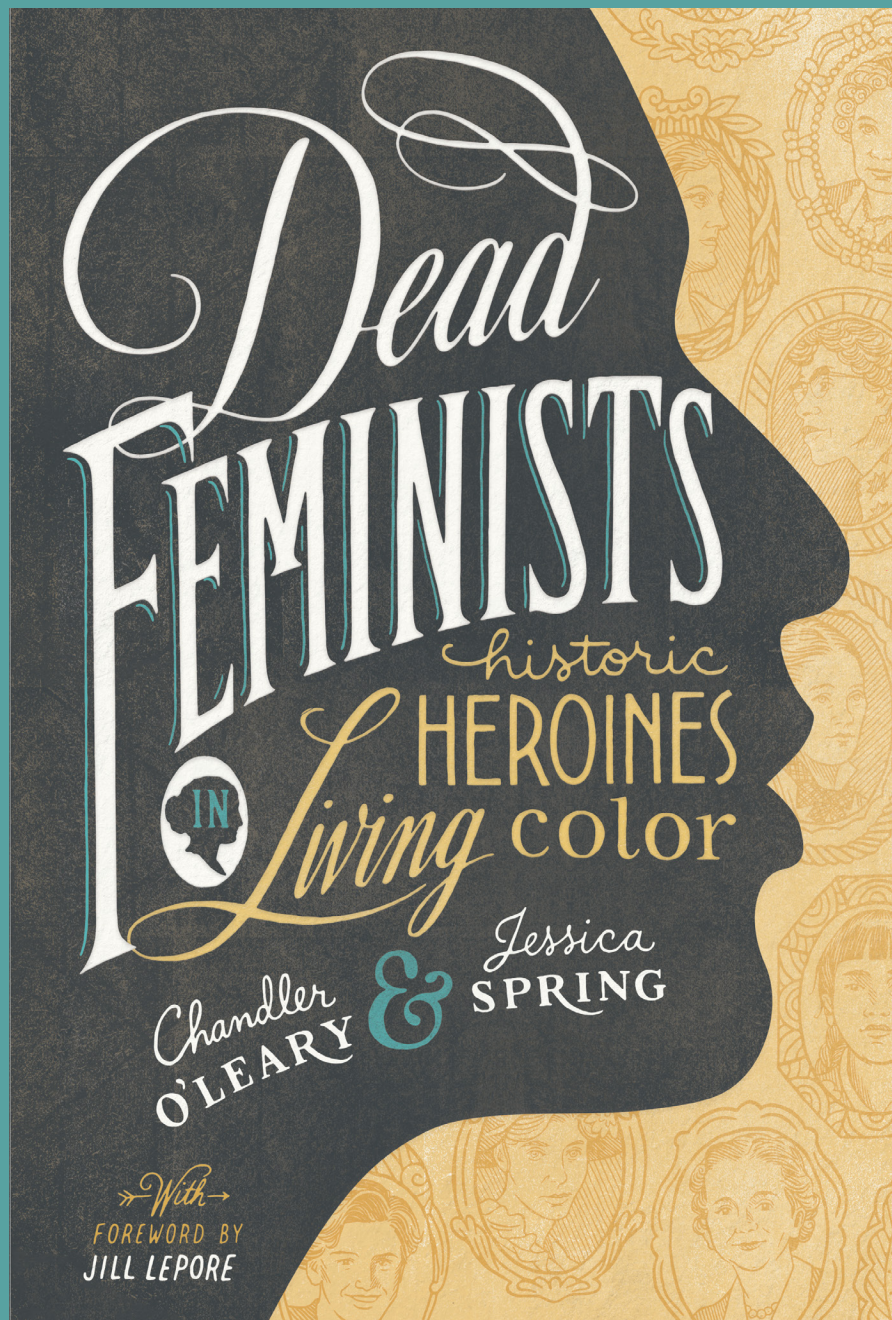

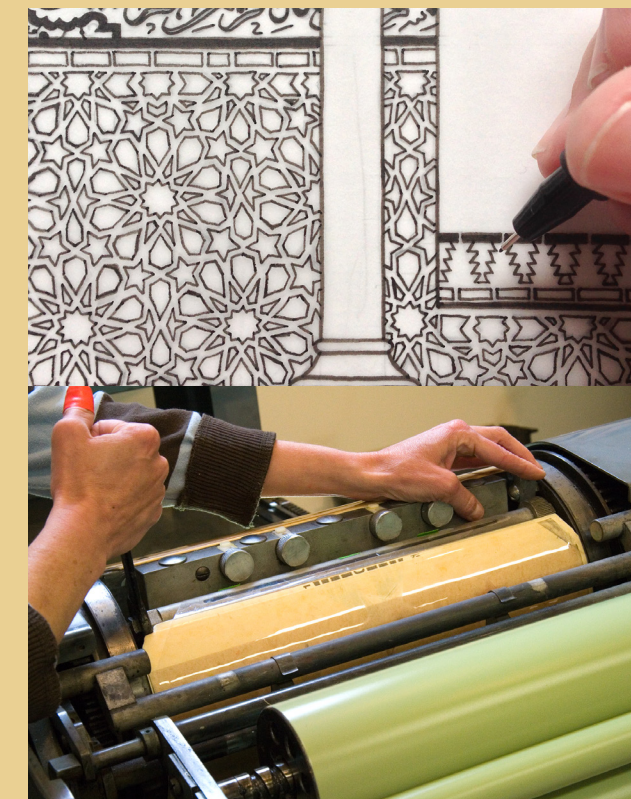
